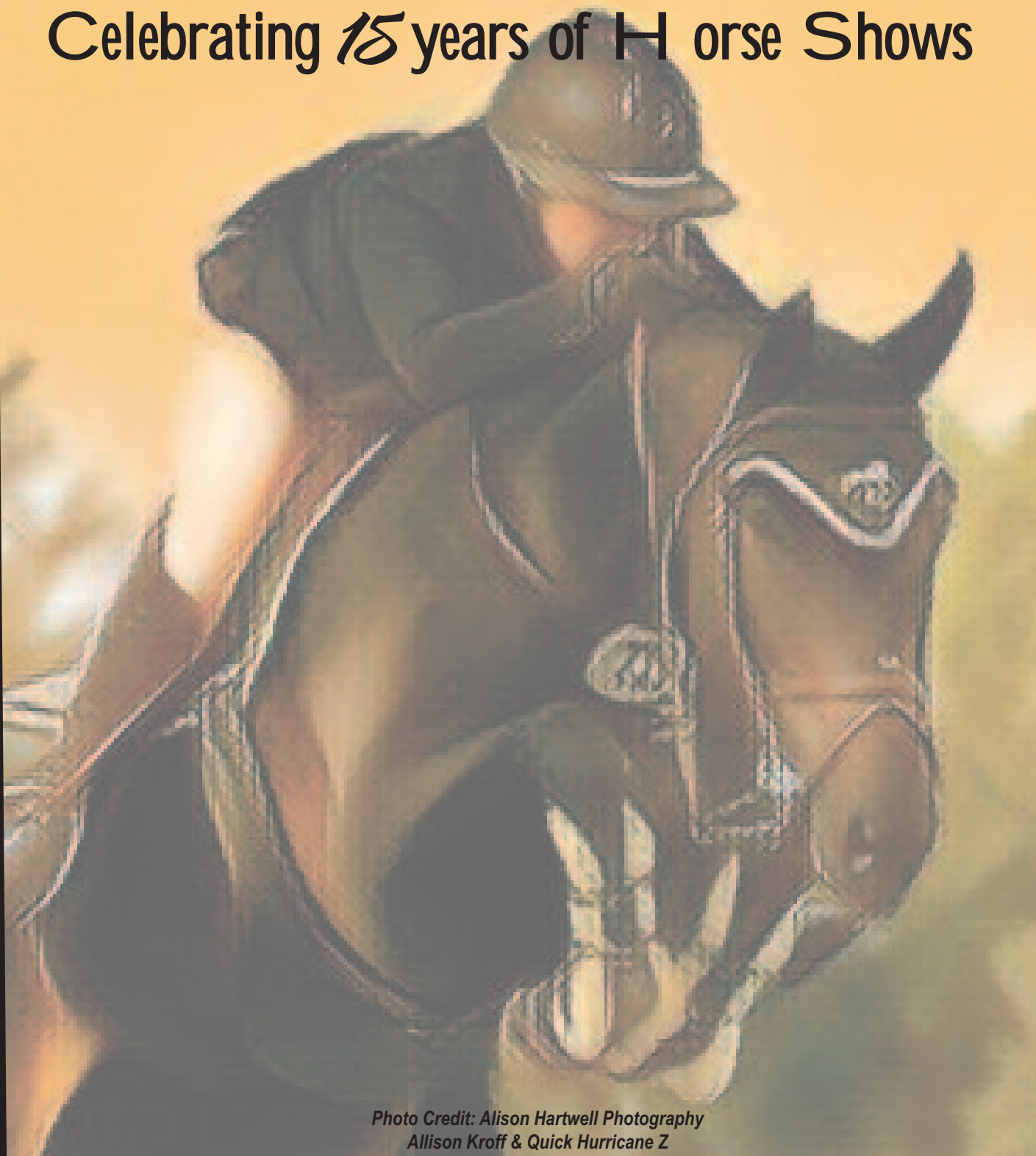

General Rules and Regulations

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current: United States Equestrian Federation "USEF" Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance there.

Stabling

Stall requests and entries for the Maffitt Lake Spring Gathering I & II will close on April 19, 2023 and Two Rivers Summer Festival I & II will close on July 12, 2023. 196 permanent stalls are available on a "first entries with checks, first received basis" @ \$210/Stall and will be located in barns A, B, C, D. All other stalls are POLE TENT STALLS and are available @ \$210/stall. PAYMENT IN FULL IS REQUIRED IN ORDER TO GUARANTEE A RESERVATION. PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE STAYING FOR BOTH WEEKS OF EACH CIRCUIT, THOSE ATTENDING ALL HOTT HORSE SHOWS and to SPONSORS. Payment should be sent with checks made payable to MAFFITT LAKE EQUESTRIAN CENTER. All blank, open checks sent to cover stabling fees will be filled out and cashed on the closing date of each particular show circuit. To determine the arrival accuracy of any stall requests, Hott Horse Shows Management will refer to the postmark date on the mailing envelope of each request mailed. All stalls are 10 x 12, **dirt/limestone flooring** and have 1/4 swing-out doors with hook closure. It is recommended to bring double end snaps and stall chains. Hott Horse Shows does not provide initial bedding. Stalls are available MONDAY, 9AM, prior to first show and every Monday thereafter at 12 noon. Horses must depart by 11am on Monday after each circuit. ALL STALL RESERVATIONS ARE NONREFUNDABLE AFTER CLOSING DATE. Should the number of stalls available be exhausted prior to the closing date all requests received that cannot be honored will be returned to the return address provided by mailer. Requests after the closing date that are honored are subject to a penalty of \$50/week. Tack stalls may be limited to one stall per every three horses entered, should lack of space be an issue. Please use the enclosed form.

Night Watch & Security

Night watch and night security is provided by Hott Horse Shows with the purchase of your stall. Please provide your name, trainer's name and emergency contact phone number on the stall sheets provided in the office.

Non-Stabling & Grounds Fee

Any horse entered in the horse show, which is not stabled on the show grounds, will be charged a \$50 grounds fee. Horses not entered in the horse show are not permitted on the show grounds.

Early Arrivals

Early arrivals are only accepted if authorized by management.

Entries

ENTRIES FOR THE **MAFFITT LAKE SPRING GATHERING HORSE SHOWS** and **TWO RIVERS SUMMER FESTIVAL HORSE SHOWS** WILL BE ACCEPTED WHEN POST-MARKED AND RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE **April 19, 2023 for May shows and July 12, 2023 for August shows**. All horses on the show grounds must have an entry on file in the office for each horse show. Horses not competing will be assessed a \$50 Non-Showing Fee. All entries must be filled out in their entirety. Numbers will not be issued if any information is missing. All add slips must be presented to starter prior to the start of class in question to gain entry into class/starting order. All entries must be closed out on the Sunday of each showing week. Only bills settled up prior to the close of business Sunday are eligible for review. Once the show week has ended all bills are final. All splitting of Tack Stalls, Feed, Bedding, Paddocks and Golf Carts must be taken care of by NOON on Friday of each week. A \$50 office fee will be charged to all horses. There are no scratch/add fees. Each horse entered for competition will be assessed a \$8 Drug Fee and \$15 USEF fee, which is forwarded to USEF as well as a \$7.00 Zone Support Fee for USHJA.

Post Entry Fee

New entries received after the closing date will be subject to a one-time charge of \$50/show. Entries are only accepted should space permit.

Scratches

Scratches must be made in the office on the official add/scratch form. Once the class has begun, adds and scratches will not be honored.

Non-Negotiable Checks

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$25 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check, money order or credit card. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.



Horse Show Office

The horse show office will be open on competition days one (1) hour prior to the first class of the day and thirty (30) minutes following the last class of the day. On non-competition days, the show office will be open on Monday from 1:00pm-4:00pm and on Tuesday from 8:30am-5:00pm.

Trainer Splits

Hott Horse Shows offers a service that allows trainers to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts and have the cost split between their clients. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment.

Check-Out

Any horse show bills not checked out at the conclusion of each show will be assessed a \$50 fee for check out. Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours.

Administration Fee and Credit Card Fee

A one-time fee of \$50/WEEK will be charged to each entry for office expenses and medical staff. MLEC does accept Master Card, Visa, and Discover. All credit card payments will incur a 3% processing fee.

Refunds

Refund of pre-paid fees will be given to show scratches received prior to or on the closing date. Refund for Horse Deposits, Stalls, Grand Prix Nominations, and Paddocks will not be given after closing date. After the start of the show in question, entries and nomination fees will be refunded only on receipt of a signed Veterinarian's/Doctor Certificate. All scratched horses that remain on the grounds will then be charged the \$50 non-showing horse fee. Any fees refunded will be less \$45 Office Processing Fee.

Membership

All US Equestrian Federation/USHJA membership numbers that apply, must be on the entry blank or a non-member fee or fees must be paid. Copies of USEF/USHJA membership cards for Owner/Rider/Trainer must accompany entries. All exhibitors in the Junior Hunters and classes restricted to ponies must present their measurement card. Amateurs must present their Amateur certification before numbers can be issued.

Leash Law

All dogs must be on a leash or locked up when on show grounds. Any owner whose dog interrupts a competitor's round will be subject to the payment of the class interrupted. Owners of loose dogs will be subject to fines.

Minors

Parent(s) or guardian (s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.

Prize Money

Prize money will be credited to entry at the completion of each class. Prize monies in excess of balances due will be presented by check upon checkout or mailed to the owner of record, unless otherwise directed, within 30 days after the completion of the show. Owners of horses competing for prize money must provide Federal ID or Social Security ID number on entry blank for money distribution. All accounts must be settled by the close of horse show to be eligible for dispute. Eight ribbons will be offered in every class, unless specified. Championships and reserve will be awarded according to GR 808, for hunter, JP 110.2 for jumper and equitation divisions. JUMPERTIES FOR OTHER THAN FIRST PLACE WILL HAVE TIME BE THE DECIDING FACTOR. Management reserves the right to mail checks after the conclusion of the horse show. Premiums can be subtracted from payments.

Paddocks

A limited number of paddocks will be available to rent for a weekly fee of \$250. All paddocks will be reserved on a first come first served basis. No more than ONE horse per paddock at a time.

Campers

A very limited amount of on-site camper spaces are available ONLY to SPONSORS. Sponsorship for campers is \$250 per week plus a \$55 pump out fee. All camper spaces require a 50 amp plug. Please bring the appropriate adapters if your camper is 30 amp. Contact Libby Hott at 515-306-1140 for reservations.

Golf Carts

Golf Carts (2 passenger) will be available for rent at \$350 per week. Reservations are required to ensure enough carts are available on-site. Outside Golf Cart Vendors are not permitted on Horse Show grounds. NO ELECTRIC GOLF CARTS MAY BE CHARGED ON SHOW GROUNDS!

Parking

Horse Trailers and Cars will be asked to park in designated areas only. Parking in the Barn Area is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Horse Vans and Trailers will be allowed in the stable areas only to load and unload. Repeat offenders will be fined.

Motorized Vehicles-Minors

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Management

Management reserves the right to refuse entries in accordance with GR914. Divisions may be combined or cancelled if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to amend the Tentative Time Schedule, as it deems necessary. Neither Hott Horse Shows, LLC, nor Tim Hott, nor Libby Hott nor Maffitt Lake Equestrian Center, LLC, nor Melinda Antisdel, nor Maffitt Lake Farms will be responsible in any way for loss or damage, to any persons, animals, property or equipment that may be caused by any horse or pony entered by Exhibitor or due to the carelessness or negligence of the person or persons in charge of such horse or pony or their subordinates. This shall be the condition of entry into the show and show grounds.

Liability/Loss/Injury

Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee, show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, sub contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) Any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold Tim or Libby Hott, Maffitt Lake Farms, Melinda G. Antisdel, Hott Horse Shows, the Maffitt Lake Equestrian Center, LLC and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF Federation and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF Federation. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.



Coggins

Current and valid Negative Coggins must be presented to Show Secretary with all entries. Numbers will not be issued without verification.

Arena Footing & Dimensions

All show arenas are limestone base with sand. Dimensions: Grand Prix Ring: 250' x 325'; Main Hunter Ring: 140' x 280'; Hunter Ring 2: 140' X 280'; Hunter Ring 3: 140' x 280'; All warm up arenas provide a limestone base with sand footing mixture.

Poling

Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited at all times while on the grounds at MAFFITT LAKE EQUESTRIAN CENTER. Exhibitors found in violation will forfeit all entry fees for that showing day or day afterwards and may be excluded from showing for 24 hours upon any incident recorded with Management and USEF Steward.

Canadian Exhibitors

The legend "US Funds" must be pre-printed on the face of all Canadian checks drawn from Canadian Banks to pay entry and stall fees.

Schooling

All horses on the grounds must have an entry form, complete with three signatures, and a signed open check or credit card. This includes non-showing horses. Tuesday will be ticketed schooling in the Main Hunter Ring and Hunter Ring 2. A ticketed judged 1.0m Jumper class will be held on Tuesday in the Graham Grand Prix Ring. Ticketed schooling is available in Hunter Ring 3 on WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY & FRIDAY, tentatively from 11am – 4pm, weather and conditions permitting. One EMT and one First Responder will be on the show grounds. Riders must wear current ASTM/SEI approved headgear while mounted. Dismounted, hand walking may be permitted in the Hunter Rings before the show starts each day. All mounted and dismounted schooling sessions will be at the discretion of Hott Horse Show Management.

Medical Waste

Due to Federal Regulations, all medical waste must be separated. Receptacles are provided for disposal of hypodermic needles in all aisles. Failure to use them will result in a \$100 fine. Please do not mix with manure waste or trash cans.

Feed and Bedding

HOTT HORSE SHOWS will be providing a full, feed and bedding service, with Purina Mills being our "Official Feed Company." Please e-mail, fax, or mail the form provided in the prize list for orders that need to be processed prior to arrival on show grounds. All other orders will need to be placed with the Show Secretary in the Show Office. NO outside feed/bedding vendors are allowed on MAFFITT LAKE EQUESTRIAN CENTER grounds. Questions should be directed to the Show Secretary. Trainers responsible for bulk orders need to arrange splits with the Show Secretary by NOON on Friday of each show week. All orders need to be placed with the Show Secretary by 3pm each day.

Championship and Reserve Championship

Hunters: Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to horses acquiring the most points in each hunter section with three or more entries and a completed Under Saddle class. Points to determine awards are as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½. Jumpers: Champion and Reserve Champion title awarded to the two horses, which have acquired the most points in each Jumper section. In the event of a tie, the award will be made jointly. Prize Money awarded in each jumper sections will count toward their respective United States Equestrian Federation Horse of the Year Awards. Points to determine awards are as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½.

Helmets

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Horse Identification

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9,) must be properly identified and obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A Registration Number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

Horse & Pony Measurement

Horses and ponies who require measurement, may be measured at the farrier's stand beginning at 10 a.m. on Friday at all horse shows.

Starting Order

A rotating jump order may be established and posted for all jumper classes, classics, and equitation medals and any other classes that have priority. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders and Trainers who have conflicts MUST see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made. No show ring will be held up due to conflicts for more than three minutes. All starting orders are drawn after the close of business the day prior to classes showing or at the USEF Steward's discretion. All accepted post entries/adds will show at the top of the starting order. All add slips must be presented to starter prior to the start of class in question.

Farrier & All Other Service Personnel

All Service orientated personnel including Farriers, Braiders, Veterinarians, Massage Therapists, etc., other than OFFICIAL contracted providers MUST check in with Tim Hott to obtain permission to work on the show grounds. Any persons found without credentials will be considered trespassing and asked to leave.

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Federation entry agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Safe Sport Statement

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.

2023 Biosecurity Protocol

Maffitt Lake Equestrian Center, LLC strives to provide the safest environment possible for all exhibitors, both equine and human, to enjoy their horse show experience. In order for Maffitt Lake Equestrian Center, LLC to offer horse shows that protect the welfare and safety of everyone involved there are protocols that must be enforced at any equestrian event during 2023.

1. A current (within 12 months of arrival on show grounds) negative Coggins test is required for all animals entering the show grounds. The Coggins MUST be presented to the show secretary upon arrival and a copy must be kept at the barn with the animal.
2. A Health Certificate must be signed by a licensed veterinarian within 14 days prior to arriving on the show grounds.
3. Current vaccination against WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus and Rabies is strongly recommended.
4. Any horse of the show grounds with a fever of unknown origin or of suspicious origin must be reported to Maffitt Lake Equestrian Center, LLC Show Management and to the show veterinarian. Isolation stalls will be available at a local veterinary hospital if the need arises.
5. Per USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation Licensed Competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.  - In case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations because of a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperatures taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, Steward, or technical delegate when requested. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.
6. Please take the time to review good equine husbandry and convey its importance to your equine caretakers.

Specifications for all Hunter Classes

Hunter Over Fences: To be shown over approximately eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. **Hunter Under Saddle:** To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. May be asked to hand gallop at the discretion of the judge, but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales not permitted. Green and non-rated sections will not be asked to gallop. **Model Class:** To be shown at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged on conformation, way of moving, and soundness. **Hunter Champion and Reserve Champion:** To be awarded to two horses scoring the most points over fences, in addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model. Half points for the 3'6" Conformation Model and the High Performance Conformation Model. **Course:** Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post and rails, aiken, and panels. In some classes, a mandatory line may restrict the area of the courtesy circle. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring by use of bushes, wood markers, or cones. **Prize Money:** 1-6 unless otherwise noted. Ribbons 1 – 8 in all "A", "C" and unrated sections unless otherwise noted. **With the exception of High Performance and the Performance Hunter 3'3" and 3'6" sections, a horse that is exhibited in the first performance class of an "A" rated section must pay a combined entry fee. After the first performance class exhibitors may enter individual classes at management's discretion (HU127.1.) All "A" rated Performance, Green Hunter and Young Hunter sections are run in accordance with HU127.1.**

Jog: Jogging will follow the modified method of trotting a circle at the end of a round.

2023 ZONE 6 HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION SPECIFICATIONS (IA, MN, ND, SD, WI, NE)

In accordance with GR1111.4: All members may compete for Zone Awards or money in any state contiguous to Zone 6: MT, WY, CO, KS, MO, IL, MI and Canada. Contiguous points earned in USEF/Equine Canada licensed competitions will only receive national points in USEF rated divisions.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS:

- To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.
- Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Sections offered and requirements:

- Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections Cross Entry:

Riders:

Riders can cross enter between the Amateur Owner 3'3" and 3'6" with a different horse. Riders in the Adult Amateur section may ride a different horse in the Amateur Owner section, and may ride in any section for which they are eligible at the same show.

Horses:

Horses may not cross enter between the Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same competition.

Horse and Rider Combination:

n/a

Fence Height:

- Not to exceed 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- Courses will not be adjusted for ponies.
- Combinations will be permitted

Combining/Dividing Sections:

May be split into three sections:

- Adult Amateurs 18 – 35
- Adult Amateurs 36 – 49
- Adult Amateurs 50 & over

If there are fewer than three (3) entries in an age group, it is to be combined with the other age group that has the least number of entries.

The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) in any of these sections. If the Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter Horse sections are combined, a horse may only compete with one rider.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Adult Amateur Hunter 18- 35
- Adult Amateur 36- 49
- Adult Amateur 50 & over

LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Eligibility:

Open to amateur riders who have reached their 18th birthday and are no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor.

Cross Entry: Riders:

Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m or 3'9".

Horses:

N/A

Horse and Rider Combination:

Horse and Rider combinations may not cross enter into any class/section where fence heights exceed 2'9" or 0.90m (Exception: 3'0" Equitation).

Fence Height:

- 2'6"

Combining/Dividing Sections:

If there are fewer than three (3) entries in the Low Adult Amateur Hunter section, it may be combined with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section.

The Low Adult Amateur Hunter Horse section may only be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony and Low Children's Hunter Horse sections after those sections have been combined and still do not meet the three (3) entry minimum.

Low Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition (If a RIDER competes in the LOW Adult Amateur section, they may NOT compete ABOVE 1.15m at the same show, but MAY also compete in the HIGH Adult Amateur section(s) on the same horse &/or any, otherwise eligible horse, and on the same day.).

High Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into 1.40/1.45m Amateur Jumper classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.35m and offering over \$1,500 in prize money at the same competition.

Horse/Pony:

Horse and Rider:

Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Adult Amateur Jumper at the same competition and on the same day as showing in Low Adult Amateur Jumpers. Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

High Adult Amateur horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.30m at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Adult Amateurs Jumpers at the same competition and on the same day. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High Adult Amateur Jumper Classics are offered. - Course design must comply with EQ108.11, however combinations are optional
- Spreads must not exceed fence height

Horse and rider combination:

The horse and rider combination may cross enter into the 3'3" Junior Hunter section.

Fence Height:

- Not to exceed 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- Combinations will be permitted

Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into Rated Pony Hunter Sections at the same competition.

Fence Height:

- Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed height of fence.
- Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed height of fence.
- Combinations prohibited

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Children's Hunter Pony section may be divided by size. If the Children's Hunter Pony is offered divided by size the sections will be: Children's Hunter Pony Small/Medium and Children's Hunter Pony Large. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either height section, the two sections must be combined. Horse/Pony:

Low Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same competition and on the same day as showing in Low Children's Jumpers. Low Children's horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.30m at the same competition. High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Children's Jumpers at the same competition and on the same day. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High Children's Jumper Classics are offered. Any horse/rider combination competing at 1.20m or above may not enter any High Children's Jumper classes with \$1,000 or more in prize money.

Fence Height:

- Low Children's Jumper 1.00m or 1.05m (choice classes run at two different heights but judged together)

- High Children's Jumper 1.10m- 1.15m

o Recommended to be conducted as a progressive section and/or offered as multiple sections at different heights.

Combining/Dividing Sections:

Low Children's and Low Adult Amateur Jumper sections must combine if there are fewer than three (3) in either section and may combine if there are fewer than six (6) in either section. If after combining the Low sections there are fewer than three (3) entries then competition management must further combine the Low sections with the High sections, allowing each section to compete at their respective height.

High Children's and High Adult Amateur Jumper sections must combine if there are fewer than three (3) in either section and may combine if there are fewer than six (6) in either section. 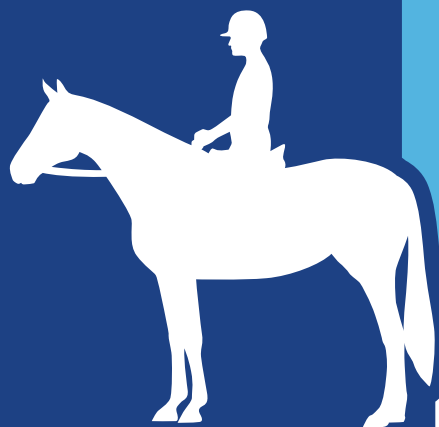
